

Discipline Policy March 2008

Delta Christian School strives to be a caring and responsible community where the dignity and safety of all, students, staff and parents, is valued and given priority. When a student's behavior breaches these standards, one or more of the following steps may be implemented in response. The steps will be determined by the severity and frequency of the inappropriate behavior.

The hierarchy of steps are as follows:

- 1. The classroom teacher deals with the student directly.
- The student is sent to the office and a discipline case statement is completed.The parents may be notified.
- 3. The student(s), with the help of his or her parents, will be required to complete a Responsibility Agreement. Depending on the nature of the offence, there will be a meeting with the parents, teacher, student and principal to discuss the incident and the course of action as outlined in the Responsibility Agreement.
- 4. If the prior steps do not lead to resolution then the situation will be brought to the board. The Board's decision will be final.
